What do we offer as the Global Council of Mission?

We offer four core pillars:

- A New Reformation as a Missiological Reformation.
- Every Muslim for Christ
- The Unreached People Group Engagement
- Discipling the Nations

Building Missionary Bridges

In the last 2 thousand years, the mission has always been a one directional highway. It was never a twoway highway.

It was a civilization to conquest toolonialism = One Way kind of model. For example, the Catholic church, as the oldest and largest institution on the planet, has aways defined the evangelistic mission as a civilizing mission, until today. The Catholics believe that mission is civilizing their targets. Also, the Catholic mission was a conquering mission. On the other side, after the reformation of 1517, the Protestant Church evangelistic mission effort was a colonizing mission. In the last 20 centuries, we witnessed these models of civilizing, conquering, and colonizing as a one-way mission effort from both the Catholic and the Protestant mission efforts.

A Two-Way Mission:

Today, it has become urgent to add another route to our current missionary efforts to include both the northern and the southern hemispheres, sending and receiving missionaries from both directions. We are ready to inaugurate a new route, a double highway to unite both hemispheres. This is the reason why we chose Paris, France for our next event.

From Europe, the Gospel was expanded throughout the whole world. Europe was the one who created the one directional way for mission. This is why we have chosen Europe and not the United States. Since the new spiritual revival is now in the whole southern hemisphere, we have already begun to send out missionaries to Europe and the northern hemisphere for the last 50 years. The new highway for missions has already begun. Now we need to create strategies to bring the Gospel back to Europe.

What is our Strategy to Build this New Road?

We will have 11 plenaries and 12 workshops aimed at provoking the Diaspora churches in Europe to action. These will be done by great missiologist and speakers carefully selected throughout the world to give the conference a road map to reaching Europe and change the demography of missions.
